

PEDIATRIC POST-OP INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE OFFICE OF DR. ROBERT BOND

ANESTHETICS: Your child may be numb following today's appointment. We try to administer the correct amount of anesthetic as needed, but it is not uncommon to still be numb for 1-2 hrs after dental appointment. Many children need to be reminded not to chew their lips and cheeks as they may injure themselves.

BRUISING/SWELLING: Some swelling or bruising is normal in the injection site. No treatment is usually needed. Contact our office if it persists or shows no improvement in more than a few days.

DIET: No restrictions unless otherwise specified.

ACTIVITY: Your child may resume normal activity immediately unless otherwise directed.
